***Light the Night for Life Will Remember 2006 Homicide Victims***  
**Indiana Project Safe Neighborhoods and The Church Federation of Greater  
Indianapolis will serve as event hosts**

(Indianapolis, IN, January 2, 2007)—Local citizens and community leaders will come together on Thursday, January 4 to remember the 153 victims of homicides killed during 2006, the second deadliest year in Indianapolis' history.

The ceremony will take place at 6pm in the Chapel of Peace on the grounds of Crown Hill Cemetery. Luminaries representing each victim will line the area around the chapel as a spotlight lights the sky. Inside the Chapel a Unity Ceremony will take place and the names of each victim will be read. Candles representing courage, hope, faith and love will be lit followed by the lighting of the unity candle.

The families of the victims have been invited to attend.
